

Objectives of general interest to be promoted by the organisation

The Sustainable Development Foundation pursues objectives of general interest aimed at supporting sustainable development and the ecological transition. The Foundation carries out research, analysis and dissemination activities, including the production of studies, publications and data-driven research, as well as the organisation of information, discussion and capacity-building initiatives.

Its activities focus on key areas of public interest such as climate neutrality and energy transition, circular and regenerative economy, green cities and sustainable mobility, and the protection and enhancement of natural capital.

The Foundation operates on a non-profit basis and uses data exclusively to support research, evidence-based policy analysis, public debate and awareness-raising, with the aim of benefiting public institutions, stakeholders and society at large, without any commercial exploitation of data.

In particular, in the field of sustainable mobility, since 2022 the Foundation has been conducting a pilot mobility survey based on citizen participation, whereby individuals voluntarily make available their daily mobility data for purposes of general interest, non-commercial use, and for the benefit of the community, with the objective of informing and supporting more effective public policies.
